2. Unrestricted elective at PVAMU (3 hours)

3. Select 6 hrs of History with at least 3 hrs of U.S. History

4. Select two courses (8 hrs) of science in Biology, Chemistry, Geology or Physics. Eight hrs of sequential courses in these areas are also acceptable.

5. Select any 3 hrs from ARTS 1303, 1304; DRAM 1310, 2361, 2362; MUSC 1301, 1306

6. Select any 3 hrs from ARTS 1303, 1304; DRAM 1310, 2361, 2362; MUSI 1306; FREN 2311, 2312; SPAN 2311, 2312

7. Course not required in the LSC-CyFair curriculum; may be transferred to PVAMU subject to a max of 72 hours.
