Bachelor of Business Administration, Management

Arianna's story: She is a native Houstonian, graduating in less than four years (at the age of 19), and has been accepted to law school. Arianna is founding president of the Center for Innovation and Entrepreneurship at PVAMU. The first-generation college graduate credits her mom with her success.

Carterica Clark:

Bachelor of Business Administration, Management

Carterica's story: First generation college student from Shreveport, Louisiana. She is also a smallbusiness owner, and started her successful company while in college, using the knowledge she obtained from PVAMU's business management programs. She secured coveted internships at the Federal Reserve Bank and the Federal Home Loan Bank.
