## OVER 950 STUDENTS TO RECEIVE DEGREES AT PVAMU'S 140<sup>TH</sup> SPRING COMMENCEMENT CONVOCATION

**PRAIRIE VIEW**, Texas (May 12, 2022) – The sky is the limit for 964 students who will soon walk across the stage at Prairie View A&M University's 140<sup>th</sup> Spring Commencement Convocation this Saturday. Ford Foundation President [Darren Walker](#) will serve as the keynote speaker.

PVAMU's number of graduating students includes 12 doctoral, 117 master's, and 832 bachelor's candidates, of which 31% identify as first-generation college students. The university's total alumni count will stand at over 80,000 Proud and Productive Panthers following the event.
