Dr. Williams, who assumed her role on August 26, 2024, is a seasoned higher education leader with a strong background in partnerships and fundraising.

On Saturday, December 14, at 9 a.m., the commencement will continue with Thasunda Brown Duckett, President and CEO of TIAA, addressing the graduates.
